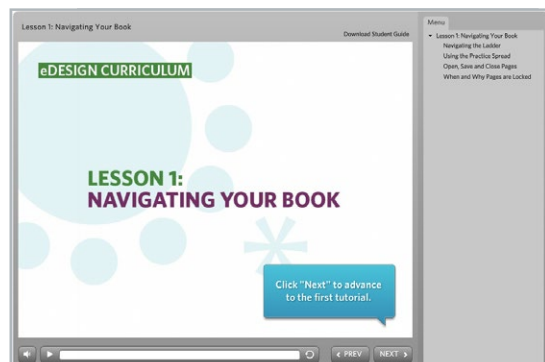
eDesign Help includes a large set of instructional resources to help you and your students maximize your productivity and enjoyment when creating your yearbook in eDesign.

eDESIGN CURRICULUM

The eDesign Curriculum is a set of eight lessons designed to give you and your students a comprehensive understanding of eDesign and to familiarize you with all of the features eDesign offers. These lessons are designed so you can take a couple of weeks at the beginning of the year to have your staff learn everything they need to make their work in eDesign fun and efficient.

Each lesson is structured around a general eDesign topic and is presented in an integrated video module that walks students through the individual tutorials that make up the lesson. Each lesson also includes an accompanying Student Guide that can be downloaded from eDesign Help and printed out for each student. The Student Guide has Guided Notes questions for each of the tutorials to increase student engagement and to improve retention of the key points. The Student Guide also includes Guided Practice exercises that a student can complete after each tutorial to reinforce his/her learning.
